

Amenities BINGO Tip Sheet

Below you'll find clues to locate the 25 activity suggestions noted on the Amenities Bingo Scorecard.

B I N G O

Find and turn on the splash pad at Stonebridge Plaza.

Visit the southwestern pillar of the blue picnic pavilion at 7501 Coronado Drive.

Build a sand castle at the Beach & Tennis Club (BTC).

Bring your Stonebridge Ranch ID to enter the pool gates at 6201 Virginia Parkway.

Wear a pair of fun sunglasses to the Aquatic Center.

Bring your Stonebridge Ranch ID to enter the pool gates at 7501 Coronado Drive.

Stroll the Stonebridge Lake dam at sunset.

For easy access, park your car at the Beach & Tennis Club (6201 Virginia Parkway).

Play a game of "horse" at the BTC basketball court.

Parking is available by the tennis courts at 6201 Virginia Parkway.

Eat a meal or snack at the Nora Haney Park picnic table.

Located on the east side of Lake Forest Drive between Glen Oaks Drive and Eldorado Parkway, this park has a convenient parking lot.

Ride your bike past the Wellington ponds.

There are seven ponds in Wellington, located west of the intersection of Stonebridge Drive and Wellington Point Road.

Take a family picture on the steps at Lake La Cima.

Lake La Cima is located at the intersection of Stonebridge Drive and Watch Hill Lane, just south of US 380.

Rent a Stonebridge Lake paddle boat at the Beach Club.

Enjoy a quiet reverie at the corner of Glen Oaks & Lake Forest.

On the northwest corner of this intersection, there are several park benches located along a short trail under the tall trees.

Climb the ropes course at Stonebridge Plaza.

The ropes course is located at the north end of the plaza at 7501 Coronado Drive, adjacent to the parking lot.

Slide down all three slides at the Park at Plainfield.

Street parking is available for this park, located at the cross streets of Plainfield Drive, Red Rock Drive, and Rayburn Drive.

BINGO WILD CARD

Read a book on the Quail Creek Park bench.

This park is located at the southwest corner of Quail Creek Drive and Lake Forest Drive. Street parking is available on Quail Creek Drive.

Visit the pergola next to the Fountainview pond.

The pergola is located on the south end of the pond at the intersection of Fountain View Drive and Custer Road.

Go fishing or take pics at the Millerd Pond dock.

Millerd Pond is located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Millard Pond Drive and Stonebridge Drive.

Fly a kite from the Stonebridge Lake dam.

For easy access, park your car at the Beach & Tennis Club (6201 Virginia Parkway).

Do cartwheels or jumping jacks in the field at Nora Haney.

Located on the east side of Lake Forest Drive, between Glen Oaks Drive and Eldorado Parkway, this park has a convenient parking lot.

How many ducks can you count at Cascades Lake?

Cascades Lake is adjacent to Tom Allen Jr. Park, a city park located at 3301 Bahnman Drive.

Invite a neighbor to play a game of pickleball or tennis.

The pickleball courts are located at 7501 Coronado Drive. The tennis courts are located at 6201 Virginia Parkway.

Walk the Serenity Park trail east of Wolford Elementary.

Located at 6701 Berkshire Road, this city-owned park also includes a small parking lot and two baseball backstops.

Play a board game on a picnic table at Stonebridge Plaza.

A large blue picnic pavilion covers multiple picnic tables at 7501 Coronado Drive.

Color with chalk on the sidewalk at Quail Creek Park.

This park is located at the southwest corner of Quail Creek Drive and Lake Forest Drive. Street parking is available on Quail Creek Drive.

Look for a rainbow in the spray of the Lake La Cima fountain.

Lake La Cima is located at the intersection of Stonebridge Drive and Watch Hill Lane, just south of US 380.

Dig up your buried toys as "treasure" in the BTC park sandbox.

Bring your sand pails and shovels. Parking is available next to the tennis courts at 6201 Virginia Parkway.
